Yoga : our fitness guru!



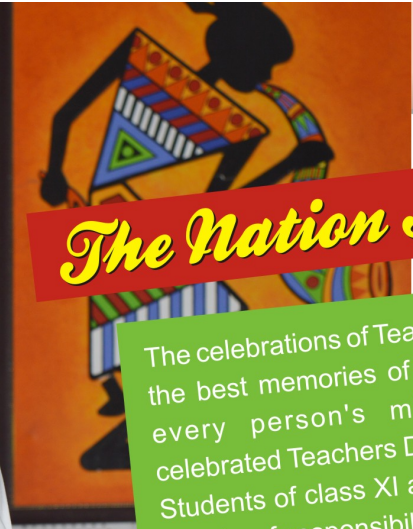
We celebrated the International Yoga Day on 21.06.2018 with a huge participation of students along with their parents and many others.

Managing waste

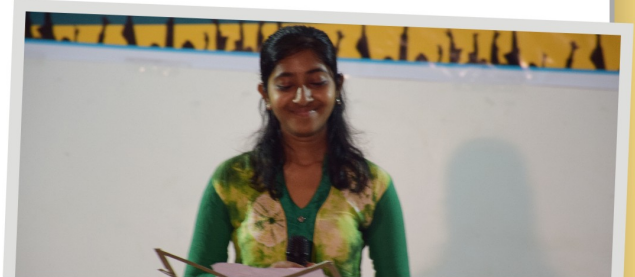

On one or the other day both the man and the trees die at the same level and rest in peace leaving all the lively memories behind.

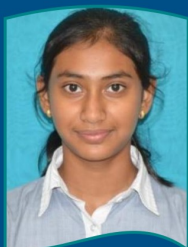

पूर्व 'यजुर्वेद' में इसका वर्णन है। भारतीय शास्त्रीय
संगीत की विशेषता राग—पद्धति है, जो किसी भी
कलाकार की व्यक्तिगत प्रतिभा को दिखलाती है। स्वर
और ताल किसी—न—किसी रूप में विश्व के सभी
संगीत में विद्यमान है, परंतु राग पद्धति केवल भारतीय
शास्त्रीय संगीत की विशेषता है।

राग वास्तव में होता क्या है? राग का मूल अर्थ है
'रंगना' या किसी भी गीत को रंग देना और इन्हीं रंगों
से मानव को प्रसन्न करना। वेदों में संगीत का संबंध
केवल जन—मनोरंजन से ही नहीं अपितु प्रकृति व
मानव शरीर से भी है। इस संगीत का मानव स्वास्थ्य
पर सकारात्मक प्रभाव पड़ता है। संगीत के स्वर तीन
सप्तक में भागित हैं— मन्द्र सप्तक, मध्य सप्तक तथा
तार सप्तक।

हमारे शरीर में सात चक्र हैं और यह सातों चक्र सातों
स्वरों पर आधारित हैं।

'सा'— मूलाधार, 'रे'— स्वाधिष्ठान, 'ग'—मणिपुर,
'म'—अनाहत, 'प'—विशुद्ध, 'ध'—आज्ञा और
'नि'—सहस्रत्र चक्र को सुचारु रखने में मदद करते हैं।
जैसे प्रत्येक स्वर किसी चक्र के लिए निर्धारित हैं, ठीक
उसी तरह प्रत्येक राग का समय निर्धारित है। इसी
तरह संगीत का हमारे जीवन व स्वास्थ्य पर गहरा
प्रभाव पड़ता है। यदि इन रागों को प्रतिदिन सुना जाए,
तो दवाइयों की आवश्यकता कम पड़ेगी।

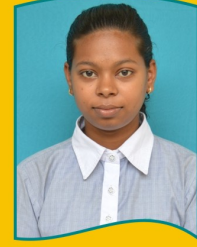

पुणे की यात्रा
