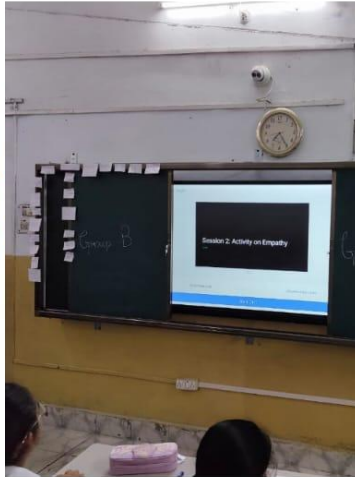


Objectives

- 2. Class teachers and peer educators facilitated the sessions, providing guidance and support.

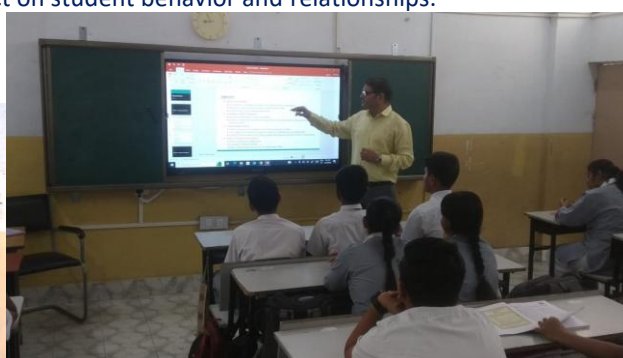


Class-wise Summary

Class IX	Students discussed case studies, identifying empathetic and non-empathetic responses and developing strategies for improvement
Class X	Students reflected on their own experiences, sharing times when they received empathetic or non-empathetic responses.
Class XI:	Students analyzed statements and developed empathetic responses, demonstrating a nuanced understanding of empathy.
Class XII	Students participated in group discussions, exploring the importance of empathy in building positive relationships.

Outcomes:

1. Students demonstrated an improved understanding of empathetic and non-empathetic statements.
2. Students developed effective strategies for practicing empathy in real-life scenarios.
3. Class teachers reported a positive impact on student behavior and relationships.
