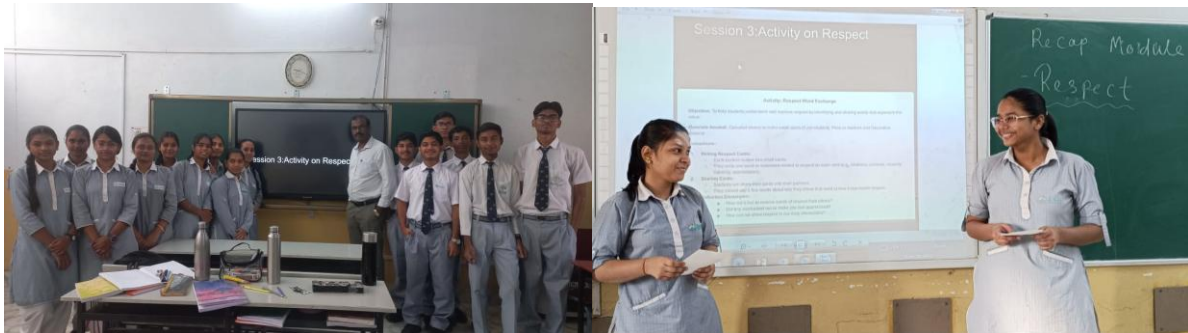
Activities Conducted

Students from classes 7th to 12th participated in the activity, demonstrating a keen interest in the theme of respect.



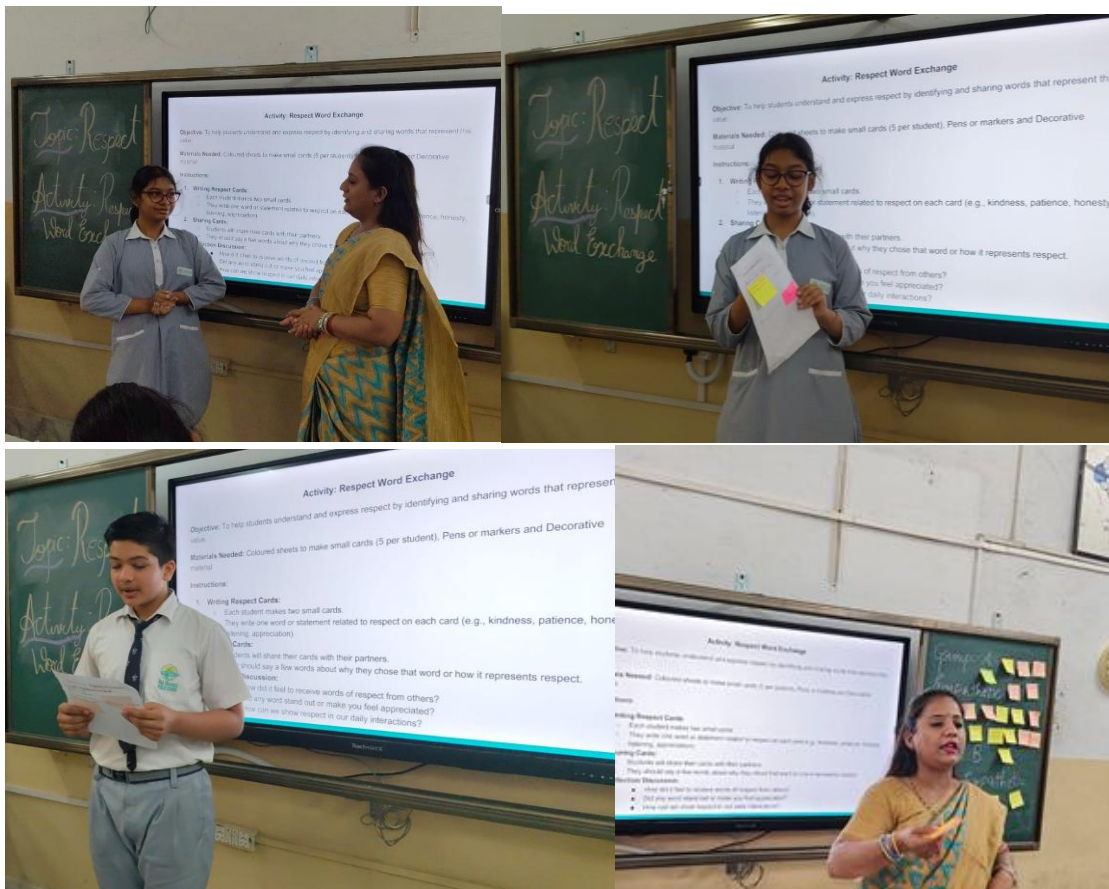
Role of Class Teachers

Class teachers played a pivotal role in facilitating the activity and guiding the discussions.



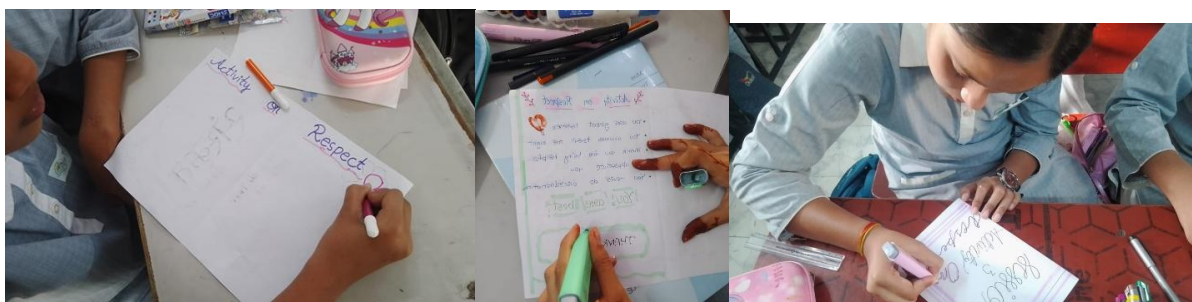
Role of Peer Educators

Activity Conduction

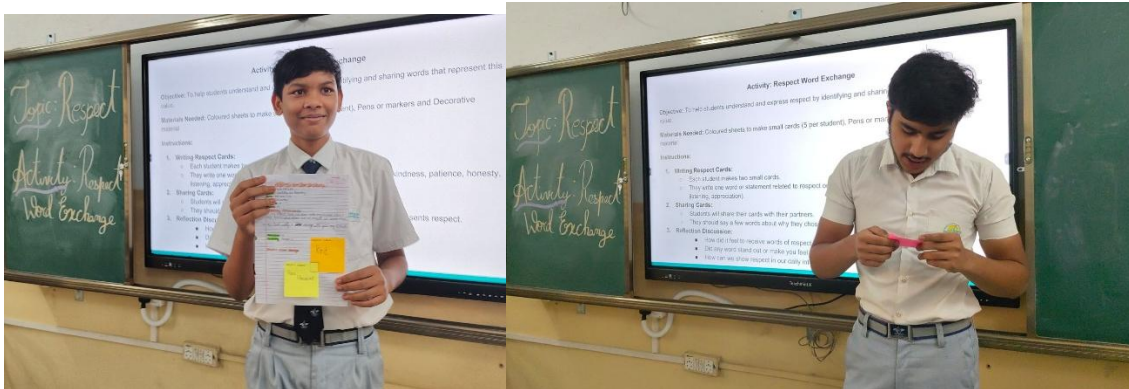
The activity was conducted in a structured manner, with students given clear instructions and guidelines. Students wrote respect cards, shared them with their friends, and engaged in reflection and discussion.



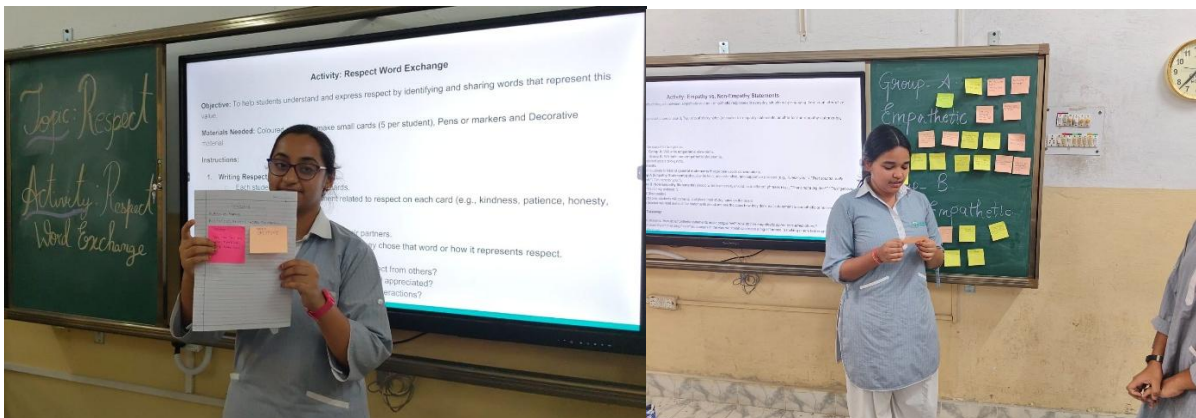


Key Features

The key features of the activity included:



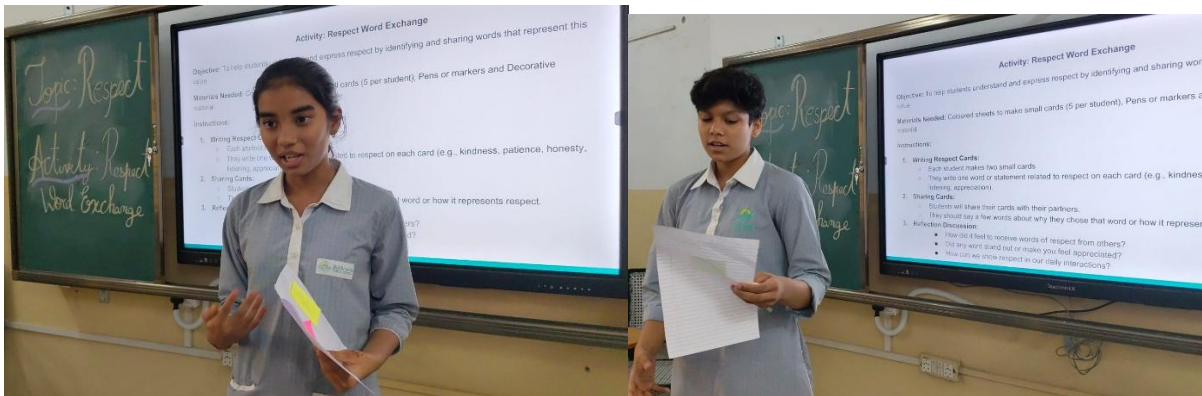
1. Writing Respect Cards: Students wrote cards with respect words and statements, reflecting on the importance of respect in their daily lives.
